Procedure for attending Services

1 Entering the Church for a service.

Entrance to the Church will be by one of three doors.

The side door opening into the corridor will enable the congregation to access the downstairs area.

The front door on the left hand side as you approach the front of the Church will provide access to the left hand side of the balcony.

The front door on the right hand side as you approach the front of the Church will provide access to the right hand side of the balcony.

It is expected that younger members will access the seating in the balcony, where places to sit will be marked only in the front row.

The duty deacon will record the point of entry for each attendee.

Each attendee should sit in the same seat every week that the regulations are in existence.

For attendees in the balcony please use a face mask so that droplets from coughs or sneezes are restrained from falling into the downstairs area.

All attendees of services should maintain social distancing on arrival and sanitise their hands from the dispensers on entering the church.

2 Leaving the Church after a service.

Attendees occupying seating in the downstairs area will exit by the Garden door and proceed via the outside side passage.

Attendees occupying seating in the balcony will leave by the same route that they entered the Church.

All attendees of services should sanitise their hands from the dispensers on leaving the church.

Maintain social distancing on leaving down the front path to the road.

3 Pastoral Needs

Should an attendee need to speak to the Pastor after the service, arrangements have been made to use the kitchen area.

4 Toilet Hygiene

In the event that you use the toilet facilities the following procedure is required before leaving and re-entering the church: -

Put on a pair of Sterile Gloves and spray the toilet seat then wipe it with a paper towel. When complete place the paper towel in the lined bin provided.

Peel off the sterile gloves and place in the lined bin.

Wash your hands using soap from the dispenser. Then dry using the air dryer or use a paper towel which when finished is put into the lined bin.

5 Matters for individual consideration.

There will be no refreshments after the service. You may want to bring your own water or juice if you are likely to need a drink.

6 Closing After each Service

Put on sterile gloves and wipe all door handles with a sanitised wipe.

Each toilet seat to be sprayed then wiped with a paper towel. Paper towel and gloves to be placed in the lined bin.

Remove bin liner and tie to close. Take home and place in household refuse bin for collection.

Replace bin liner for next service.
